



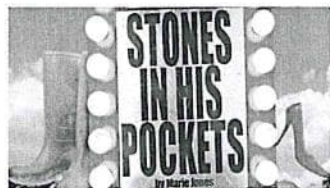
### Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> May

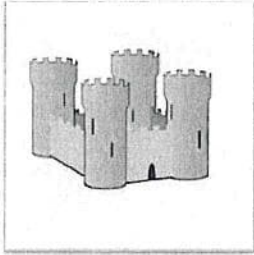

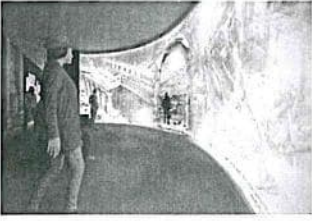


### **SATURDAY 24<sup>TH</sup> JUNE**
