No excursions are offered to students on their arrival/departure days.

Lessons

- Our unique programme offers a mixture of all language skills and also university skills suitable for studying anywhere in the world. The 15 hours of tuition include public speaking, debating, presentations, how to take notes, essay planning, time management, summary writing, some academic English and the opportunity to speak to recent graduates about what studying at university is really like. Students improve their English, and also to learn skills useful for their future lives. Lower level students will concentrate more on learning general English than university skills.

Excursions

- Students take part in all the excursions and travel is included. Every week students will have a university taster session where they have the opportunity to experience what studying at university will be like. These will take place in different departments of various universities. The other activities offer a mixture of fun, sightseeing and of course shopping. They are supervised by Excel English activity staff and group leaders. On Saturdays the students have day trips outside London. Admissions are included (except for Sundays where group leaders arrange their own excursions or students decide with Excel English staff what they would like to do).

Evening Activities

- One evening is a guided night time walk. The activities on the other evening could include garden games / sport /pamper sessions / art / films. On other nights students in the residence will have additional activities organised by the Excel English activity leaders or their group leaders.


Evenings with homestay hosts

- The Excel English Summer Programme is very full and tiring so we have included time for the students to relax, talk with their homestay hosts, practise their English and update their social media. Students must not go out in the evenings unless group leaders have organised extra excursions and informed the school in advance.
