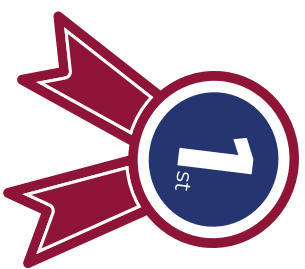

Academic

All students will have 15 hours of tuition each week. There are a range of subject options at each school designed to improve our students' ability to use English communicatively. All students take part in our 'Time to Shine' programme, in which they develop the 21st century skills of communication, collaboration, problem solving and critical thinking through interactive projects. Class sizes are a maximum of 15 students. At the end of the course students will receive a report and certificate of attendance.

Social Programme

Our Summer School Social Programmes are designed specially to promote fitness, fun and friendship. In the afternoons, our multi-activity sessions give students the opportunity to choose from a wide range of options including: Football, Tennis, Swimming, Arts, baking and nature walks. Every evening, exciting whole-school events take place, where all students come together for talent shows, discos, sports tournaments, and unique SBC events like Staff Safari and Capture the Flag.

English Plus

On two afternoons each week students can choose to take an English Plus+ option. These are optional activities led by a specialist instructor. Options include: Adventure Sports, Horse Riding, Water Sports, Art and Design, Intensive English and Drama. English Plus+ courses have a supplementary charge.

Excursions

Our Excursion Programme gives students the opportunity to explore some of the UK's most famous cities and attractions. Students will have two excursions per week, (except during their departure week where there will be one excursion). Destinations for this summer include: London, Oxford, Bath, Thorpe Theme Park and Legoland.

Academic

All students will have 15 hours of tuition each week in their chosen subject. Each course is designed to develop our students' English language skills and subject knowledge. Every student takes part in our 'Time to Shine' programme, in which they develop their research, collaboration, communication and presentation skills in teamwork projects connected to their chosen Elective Subject.

Leadership

All Summer Academy students will participate in 10 hours of leadership development each week. This exciting programme is designed to challenge students, build reflective practice and enhance leadership skills. Through a combination of classroom based learning and practical workshops our students have the opportunity to grow and develop as the leaders of tomorrow.

Social Programme

The Summer Academy Social Programme allows students to socialise with friends through our wellbeing activities and evening events. Students can choose from a varied schedule which includes sports and fitness activities, mindfulness sessions, art and creative workshops and cultural visits. Excursions

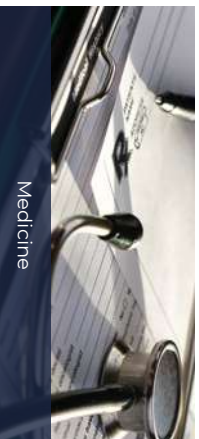

Make a Booking

We recommend booking early as course places are limited. If you are a travel agent or booking on behalf of a family, please let us know at the time of booking.

Confirmation of Place

Upon receipt of your completed booking form, we will send you confirmation of your place, alongside an invoice and a welcome pack with information about your chosen school or college.

Payment of Fees

A deposit of £700 is required to secure your booking. The remaining course fees must be paid by the 11th May 2020. Any bookings after this date must be paid in full at the time of booking.

Transfers

For a supplementary fee we offer an Airport Transfer service to and from Heathrow Airport. Please ask us about this at the time of booking.

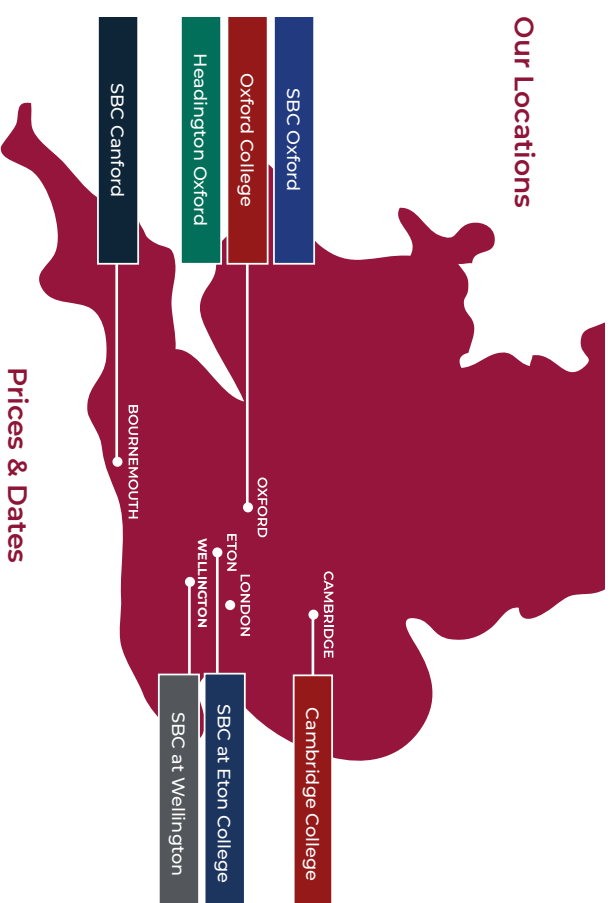
