

The Irish College of English is recognised by ACELS, a service of Quality and Qualifications Ireland, for English Language Teaching. Progression is our focus and we aim to develop a natural interest and love of the language in our students. As part of our academic policy, students are evaluated on registration and placed at the correct level. On completion of their course, students receive a progress report from their teacher and a certificate of attainment.


