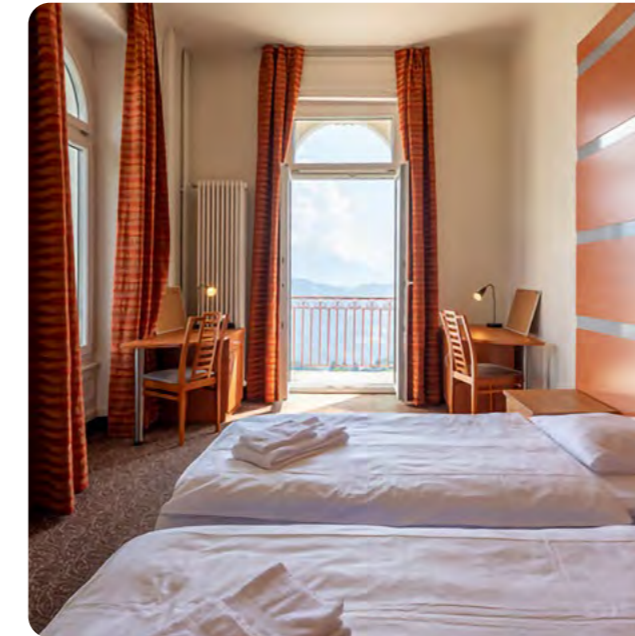

Teaching Methods & Curriculum

Teachers are encouraged to use flexible and diverse teaching methods and techniques. Classes will be fun and engaging whilst ensuring students are learning and progressing in their studies. The lessons are based around language acquisition and immersive learning, meaning students will acquire specific language skills and then be given the chance to use them in real life situations. Our curriculum focuses on a range of topics, and we use predominately speaking, listening and reading. Each morning of classes ends with a project hour that allows students to collaborate across levels and even languages. The result of the project hour each week will be presented by students on Friday and serves as a reminder and evidence of the progress made each week.

Group Levels

We welcome all students and at all stages of their language learning. However, for us to place you into the correct level for your language course, it is important that you let us know your current level (beginner, intermediate, advanced) for your chosen language. During the application you will be asked for this information and will be given a short speaking assessment on your arrival at camp. With your teacher's agreement, you will be able to change levels if you feel you have been placed wrongly.

The Teachers

Our team of qualified and motivated teachers makes courses interesting and interactive. Classes are designed to provide relaxed learning conditions.

Class Atmosphere

At Swiss Education Academy camps, be inspired and filled with enthusiasm from day one by the great atmosphere that makes up the camp life. An ideal setting for you to enjoy learning a foreign language.

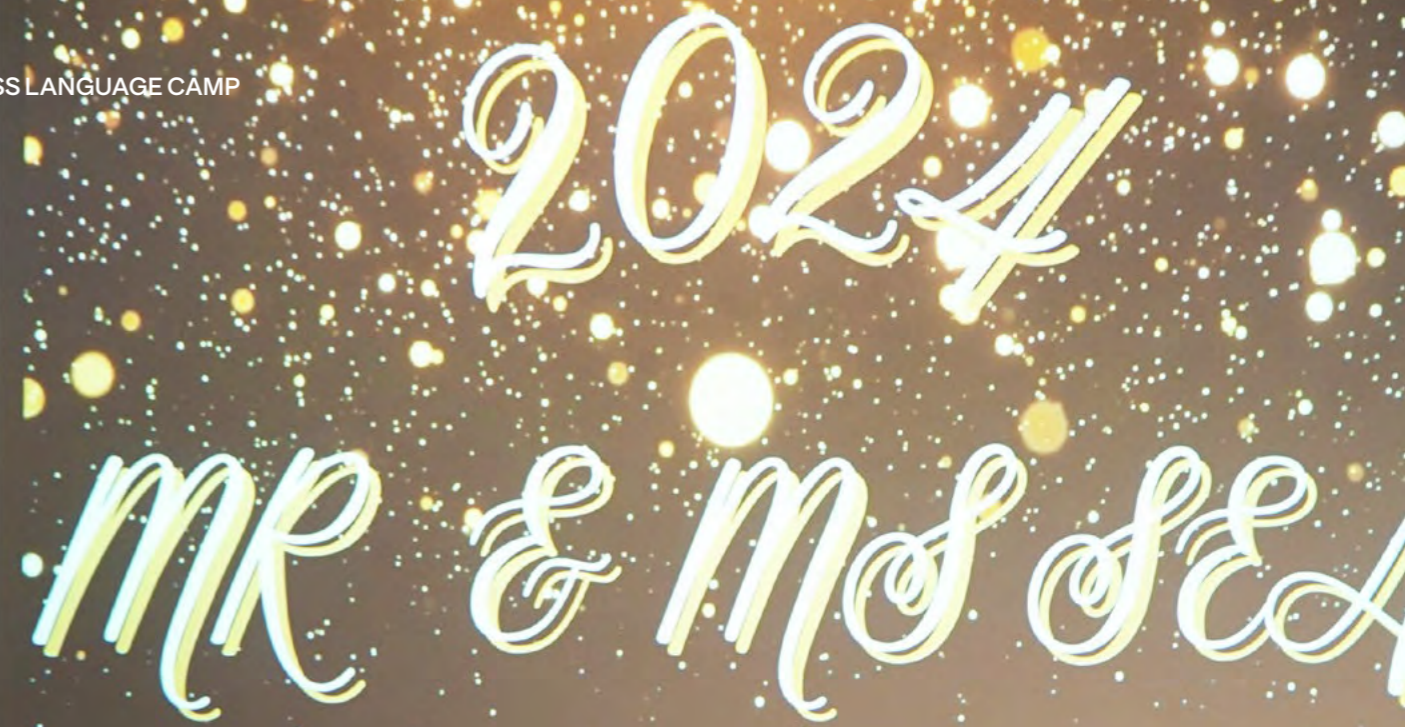


Cailler Chocolate Factory

Course Structure
