CAMP RULES AND AGREEMENT

On the premise that A2Z s.r.l. (hereinafter A2Z) organizes summer camps for campers aged 6 to 17; that camps will run in the following periods in 2022: Junior Discovery from June 12 to July 23, Outdoor Exploration from June 19 to July 23, Sea Quest from July 3 to July 23, and Alphabet City from July 10 to July 23; that it is the intention of the signatory to adhere to this initiative; that this enrollment form is a contract governed by Italian law;

it is agreed that:

Art. 1 – PREMISES

The abovementioned premises constitute an integral and essential part of the agreement.

Art. 2 – PARTICIPATION

Participation in Junior Discovery camp is open to campers aged 6 to 12. Participation in Outdoor Exploration camp is open to campers aged 12 to 17. Participation in Sea Quest camp is open to campers aged 12 to 17. Participation in Alphabet City camp is open to campers aged 12 to 17.

Registration for each camp is formalized by completing the enrollment form in all its parts together with an agreed deposit payment. <u>Participation is subject to payment in full.</u>

Art. 3 – PARTICIPANTS

There will be a minimum of 15 participants and a maximum of 40 participants per week at each of our residential camps, Junior Discovery, Outdoor Exploration and Alphabet City. Sea Quest will have a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 8 participants per boat per one-week period.

Art. 4 – PRICES

The final price is calculated as the sum total of all the elements of the holiday (stay, transfers, excursions) minus any applicable discounts inserted in the table on p. 4 for Junior Discovery, p. 5 for Outdoor Exploration, p. 6 for Sea Quest, p. 7 for Alphabet City or p. 8 for the special Multi-Camp offers. Payment may be divided in two: a deposit payment equal to 50% of the total price payable within 10 days of registration, and the remaining balance payable by April 30, 2022. In the event a camper is enrolled after this date, the full balance is due at the time of registration, as mentioned in Art. 16.

The deposit paid at the time of enrollment represents a down payment necessary to hold a spot and is nonrefundable, except in case of the cancellation of the camp on the part of A2Z, as mentioned in Art. 5, or any withdrawals in accordance with the parameters stated in Art. 7.

The enrollment price covers the cost of registration, 3rd party insurance, an English language initial assessment test, all academic materials, accommodation, all living expenses during the participant's stay, sports and other activities, English lessons with qualified English mother-tongue teachers, the use of the facilities and equipment, unlimited soft drinks, three meals and two snacks per day, daily room cleaning service, plus all extras selected such as transfers or excursions.

Art. 5 – CANCELLATION OF THE CAMP

A2Z reserves the right to cancel the camp if participants don't reach the minimum number set out in Art. 3, in which case the camper has the right to a full refund of all fees paid, without exception.

Art. 6 – CHANGES

The organizers reserve the right to make changes to the program before and/or during the camp in the event of technical or organizational needs, or under any circumstances that may require it.





Art. 7 – WITHDRAWAL (BEFORE OR DURING THE CAMP)

Following the COVID-19 pandemic and the relative uncertainty over the regular execution of all activities, we have decided to waive our cancellation policy for the 2022 edition. If a camper must cancel a booking prior to their arrival at camp, we will refund 100% of all fees paid.

Any camper who withdraws from the summer camp once it is underway has no right to a refund for any days missed.

Art. 8 – COVID-19 PREVENTION

For the safety of all participants, access to the summer camps will be allowed only upon presentation of a COVID-19 vaccination certificate, or a negative swab test (molecular or antigenic) carried out no later than 48 hours before arrival at camp.

Art. 9 – DISMISSAL FROM THE CAMP

A2Z reserves the absolute right to dismiss any participant who shows an inability to adapt to group life and who causes any serious disturbance to the activities with behavior that is not in keeping with the spirit of the camp. Any serious violation of "common sense" rules, such as damage to property, a lack of respect for staff of any kind and to any degree, or disrespectful behavior during activities and recreation time will result in the participant's immediate dismissal from camp. Regardless of the unpleasant nature of dismissal, the abovementioned measures are necessary in order to guarantee the health, balance and protection of individual participants and the community as a whole. In the case of dismissal, the participant will not have the right to any refund.

Art. 10 – OBJECTS NOT PERMITTED

The following objects are **forbidden**: items such as radios, CD/DVD players, mp3 players, penknives, videogames, iPads, food, computers, TVs, fireworks, mobile telephones, sweets/candy, chewing/bubble gum, cosmetics, razors, laser pointers, water or air guns and other objects that could be considered dangerous. If any of the abovementioned objects or other similar objects that the staff consider unsuitable are brought to the camp, they will be confiscated and returned to the participant or their parents at the end of camp.

Art. 11 – RECEPTION AND DEPARTURE

On arrival, participants are taken into the care by the camp staff directly from the parent or legal guardian. At the end of camp, participants are only allowed to be picked up by the parent or legal guardian, or a person in possession of the necessary written authorization signed by one of the participant's parents or legal guardians and on presentation of a valid form of identification.

Art. 12 – SWIMMING ABILITY

All participants must be competent swimmers.

Art. 13 – INSURANCE

Enrollment includes 3rd party liability coverage only.

Art. 14 - LOST OR DAMAGED PROPERTY

A2Z is not responsible for the loss, theft or damage to participants' personal items or valuables prior to, during or following camp activities.





Art. 15 – OBSERVATIONS AND JURISDICTION

Any complaints and/or observations by parents should be communicated solely and exclusively to the Camp Director in charge of the summer camp.

Any dispute regarding the validity , interpretation , execution and / or termination of the contract shall be referred to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Court of Rome.

Art. 16 - PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

I, the undersigned, authorize A2Z to process, archive and use my personal data to the sole purpose of processing the enrollment to the camp and keep me up to date with its programs. In accordance with law 675/96 for the protection of privacy, I may request at any time the deletion or rectification of data kept by A2Z

During the camp, video and photographic footage will be recorded. I, the undersigned, authorize A2Z to use
photos taken or video footage recorded to be added to the company's website and the publication of
informational materials with the sole aim of reporting the camp's activities.

Art.18 - DISCLAIMER

Except as expressly mentioned in Annex 8 of the DPCM 17 May 2020, and assumptions of misconduct and/or negligence attributable to A2Z, it is understood between the Parties, that A2Z does not respond for prejudice and any damages suffered, direct or indirect, subjective or objective, arising from possible contagion from Covid-19, that may result from the malicious or involuntary act of the campers and/or counselors or third parties in general, who are obliged to expressly exempt A2Z from any action, reason, claim for direct or indirect damages, and any liability, expenses, even legal, suffered or sustained, and any adverse consequences suffered, administrative sanction that find cause or reason in any case, in violation of the precepts provided by this contract or the non-compliance of applicable legal requirements and regulations.
